He states that he entisted in the service of the united states in the regular army for the Term of three years and Served out the so term of three years. He enlisted in the bounty of Glauster in the state of No but the time of his intestment he does not at this time recollect He enlisted under Cafilaw Thomas Baylop in Decond No State Progement. He then marched to Nampton to after he was there he was enceutated for the small pooks. He afterwards was marehed to the Nalley Horge where he joined the army under Teneral Washington at which place he remained all Wenter the heeft Summer he was marelied after the British and under the Command of bolovel Charles I alucy he overtock the British at monerouth church and was in and engagement with the British one whole day and lay on his armes all night experience to engage again on the need day but on that night the British got on board Their ships . He gurther states that he was in a stirmisto with the Bulish at Saw mile river bridge near fort Moulgomery under the Command of bolonel Samuel Buefs and in that shirmish twenty right soldiers and two officers Taken by the British. No further states that he was in another engagement and was in front of the army in taking Stoney from Fort under the Command of General Authory Weigne at which engagement Stend Wayne received a small wound in his Tempte and then boloved Seelocher took the Command. bold Glung was the commander of the Vanguard he received no wound . He state that hel Isomied a descharge in writing which discharge was definited in the Suchities He states that he is known to Williams No line and Richard Brinkley who are his neighbors. He lumby relinquishes every claim whatever to a pression or assmuty segrept the firesent and declares that his mane is not on the forsion roll of the agency of any state. Sworn to and subscribed the day and year afores aid And the said William Wo tinte and Probert Brentiley here in Bourt state that they are wed acquainted with Williams Meyser who has substill and Sworn to the above declaration that we believe him to be seventy feven years

of age that he is refuted and believed in the neighborhood where he reside

It have been a soldier of the accordation and that we cencer in that offering do the said bout do harby destan their of wiew after the wees lighter of the practice and after furthing the interrogations presented by the War defractment that the above named applicant was a rectitionary soldier and served as he states—
