"This day Fleming Keyser personally appeared before the undersigned justice of the peace for the said county of Bath sitting in open court who make out that he is the son and executor of William Keyser deceased late a pensioner of the United States; that the paper hereto assessed was found by the applicant among the papers of the said William Keyser deceased after his death carefully filed among his important papers and that the said paper has been in possession of the applicant ever since. The applicant further made oath that the said paper purporting to be a register of the births of his children commencing with "Polly was January 26, 1782" and ending with "Sally was born September 13th, 1806" is the handwriting of the said William Keyser deceased. The applicant further made oath that he has often heard his father say that he had lost the original register of his children's births and that many years ago he had obtained from his neighbor Richard Sneed a register of the births of his own children which he had set down on a piece of paper and that on the opposite side of the same paper he had made a register of the births of his own (Keyser's) children which he was only enabled to make out by a comparison between the ages of his own children and those of the said Richard Sneed.
